

Background

For the financial year 2025-26 Wheatley Parish Council (WPC) has set the precept for a Band D property at £93.67 (an increase of 5% or £4.46), this will generate a total precept of £169,011 that the WPC will use to manage and maintain its facilities and to expand the services it offers to the community.

Unlike our District and County Council's WPC do not receive any funding from central government or business rates, we are only able to carry out the work we do through the precept, paid by households in Wheatley.
