New permit scheme for garden waste Remember, all recycling MUST be CLEAN, DRY collections and placed in your recycling bin LOOSE!

If you are a garden waste collection user, please read this important information

To receive garden waste collections from 1 April 2025, you must purchase an annual permit. This is replacing the previous direct debit process and payment. When you receive the permit, stick it on the lid of your brown bin as instructed in the following information.

Here's what you need to do in two simple steps:



Scan the QR code below. visit southandvale.gov.uk/GardenWastePermit or call 01235 422422 to make a one-off, annual payment for your garden waste collections. This will replace your current direct debit.



When you get it, stick your permit to the lid of your brown bin.

You can also sign up for an online account on our website to make things easier when you need to purchase your next permit in 2026.

Never put used household batteries, vapes or electrical items in your recycling bin - they're a major fire risk!

Vapes and electrical items should go in a plastic bag next to your black bin on collection day. Household batteries go in a small clear bag placed on the lid of your recycling bin on collection day.





Too much recycling to go in your bin? Put extra recycling loose in an open cardboard box or in a clear sack next to your green recycling bin.

All bins should be presented for collection by 6am with lids fully closed. Report a missed collection:

You must report a missed collection by 5pm if you are contacting us by phone or by midnight if reporting it online, on the next working day immediately following your collection day.
